

How to view Form 26 AS/ Income Tax Credit Statement through Income Tax website:

Step 1: Log in to incometaxindiaefiling.gov.in. (If you have not yet registered on e-filing website, you will have to create log in by registering yourself on the e-filing website filling in the details of your PAN and other details)

Open the following link to directly reach the login page of the Income Tax e-filing website.

Step 2: After Logging into your account, select the option View Form 26AS (Tax credit) under the 'My Account' tab

STEP 3:

- Now it will ask to confirm for redirection to TDS-CPC website. Click confirm.
- You will be redirected to TRACES Website.

Step 4: On TRACES page click on the link **Proceed to View (Form 26AS)** given at the bottom of the page. As shown in the image below.

Annual Tax Statement (Form 26AS) is now generated from TRACES.

Form 26AS contains details of:

- Tax deducted by deductors on behalf of Tax Payer
- Tax collected by collectors on behalf of Tax Payer
- Advance / Self-Assessment tax deposited by Tax Payer
- Refund paid by ITD to Tax Payer
- AIR Transactions

Form 26AS can be viewed by registering with TRACES or through net banking account of tax payers held with banks that have registered with TRACES to provide this facility.

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STEP 5:

- Here it will take you to Form 26 AS (tax credit statement).
- Select the Assessment year from the drop down arrow. For the current financial year 2016-17, 2017-18 will be the relevant Assessment Year.
- Also select the option of HTML or PDF from the View As drop down arrow.

Step 6- On selection of the appropriate Assessment Year and View as, click on view/Download.

- Now you will be viewing your Income Tax credit statement.
- Form 26 AS for the Assessment Year 2017-18 shows the details of :
 - All taxes deducted by your employer, bank or any other person from your incomes for the year 2016-17
 - Taxes deposited by you as Advance Tax or Self-Assessment Tax for the year 2016-17
 - Refunds granted to you by IT Department.
